NL NIS implementation approach

- National CSIRT: Minister of S&J/NCSC-NL
- Single point of contact: Minister of S&J/NCSC
- Competent authorities: differs per sector
- Thresholds
 - Determined by sectors
 - NCSC facilitated the sessions
 - Confidential
- Wgmc (Dutch act on Data processing and Cybersecurity notification (October 1st 2017)
 - Formal task of NCSC-NL
 - Confidentiality (press; regulators; FoIA)
 - Mandatory incident reporting
- Implementation of NIS: Cybersecurity law
 - Currently working on new version after consultation
 - Arranges NIS implementation, parts of Wgmc are incorporated





NL NIS implementation approach

- Regulation
 - Separation CSIRT (help) /supervisor (enforcement)
 - Confidentiality article
- Sectors
 - Determined by ministries within the government
 - Sub-set of critical services relevant for NIS
- Constituents
 - Communication
 - Limited capacity (or: full agenda's)
- Internal organisation
 - Processes, infrastructure





NL NIS implementation difficulties

- Vital vs. Essential
- DSPs
 - Not appointed, Cf. trust services (eIDAS regulation)
 - Separate CSIRT for DSPs
- Fine
 - Fines differ a lot in existing regulation
 - Arranges rest of NIS implementation
- Sectors/Operators of essential services
 - · Determined by ministries
 - Sub-set of critical services relevant for NIS
- Thresholds
 - Determined by sectors
 - NCSC facilitated the sessions
 - Confidential
- Wgmc in effect on October 1st 2017
 - Formal task of NCSC-NL
- Trusted CSIRTs
 - Appointed by Minister of Security and Justice
 - · Start with limited set, perform legal test for each additional (National) CSIRT
- Competent authorities (not specified for every sector yet)
